

MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS

OTTAWA, Monday, June 19, 2023 (41)

The Standing Senate Committee on Human Rights met in camera this day at 4:28 p.m., in room B45, Senate of Canada Building, the chair, the Honourable Salma Ataullahjan, presiding.

Pursuant to the order of reference adopted by the Senate on Thursday, March 3, 2022, the committee continued its study of such issues as may arise from time to time relating to human rights generally.
