

MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS

OTTAWA, Tuesday, September 17, 2024 (94)

The Standing Senate Committee on Transport and Communications met in camera this day at 9:02 a.m., in room B45, Senate of Canada Building, the chair, the Honourable Leo Housakos, presiding.
