Subject: Bill S-2, An Act to amend the Indian Act (new registration entitlements)

Hello Senator Audette.

I would like to bring to the attention of your Committee an issue in regard to the process surrounding 'Indian Status', specifically dealing with the Indian Register – the issue of missing records.

I raised the issue of missing records related to Indigenous People as a witness before this Committee in September 2023 regarding records related to Residential Schools. This same issue, I believe, exists with what this Committee is examining now.

The Indian Registrar does not seem to have a complete set of records that would allow Indigenous Services Canada (ISC) to conduct a fair and just investigation and proper analysis for some individuals who have applied for and who may be applying for 'Indian Status' under the Indian Act.

According to ISC, the Indian Register is based on lists that were posted in First Nation communities in 1951. Prior to 1951, the lists were decentralized and managed at Indian Agency offices:

"The sources for these records included Annuity Paylists, Treaty Paylists, Interest Distribution Paylists, and in some cases irregular census records, all held by the [Indian Affairs] Genealogical Unit."[\[1\]](#)

ATIP records received from the Federal government in the research that I have undertaken regarding identifying missing Residential School children indicate that the Federal government does not have a complete set of these records, specifically Treaty, Annuity and Interest Distribution Paylists.

For example, in my attempts to identify Indigenous children who died while students at the Shingwauk and Wawanosh Indian Residential Schools in Sault Ste Marie, Ontario (Robinson-Huron (1850) Treaty Territory) between 1910 - 1920, records released in ISC ATIP A-2022-00151[\[2\]](#) show that many record 'gaps' in Paylists exist for many First Nations located in Ontario. Furthermore, the separate Treaty Paylists for Ontario IRS students (Form 81)[\[3\]](#) have not been located and may no longer exist. These missing Residential School Treaty Paylists may be one of the reasons why ISC was unable to provide any information regarding the Indigenous children who I previously mentioned who died at an IRS.[\[4\]](#)

This is just a small sample of missing records for a ten year period for First Nations people located in Ontario. I hope that the Committee invites the Indian Registrar, the sole authority for determining which names will be added, deleted or omitted from the Indian Register, to explain how this registration process works given the paucity of records held by Canada.
