



BLOCK 2 REDEVELOPMENT OVERVIEW


- Block 2 is an Ottawa city block situated directly across Parliament Hill.
- Responds to short-term need to create senators' office space while the rehabilitation of core buildings, such as East Block and the Confederation Building. In the long-term, provides permanent office accommodations for parliamentarians, and will address future growth and enable consolidation,
- An Architectural Design Competition was launched in 2020 to ensure design excellence.
- A new tower, located within the eastern portion of Block 2, is intended for the Senate.



Key Considerations


- Opportunity: Include Victoria Building into the Block 2 redevelopment, as the building is in poor condition
- Challenge: Extremely limited geographic boundaries for Senator Office swing space (South of Sparks between Bank and Elgin Streets)

CURRENT DISTRIBUTION OF SENATE POUS




PHASE 1 - AROUND 2027

- Current strategy indicates that the National Capital Commission (NCC) will vacate 40Elgin in three phases
- Victoria Building would be completely vacated into 40 Elgin




PHASE 2 - LATE 2020s

East Block occupants would be vacated into the East tower in Block 2.




PHASE 3 – EARLY 2030S

SCB occupants move back to Centre Block.




PHASE 4 – MID 2030
